Why I'm sharing this

NEAR-VERBATIM FROM RICK'S INTRO RECORDING

So, hey Patreon, listen—I'm always listening to stuff. I'm learning every day and I'm always looking for things that I can share with you. This is one of those videos. I listen to Myron Golden on a regular basis. I've never met him. One day I will, but I consider him a mentor and I glean a lot from his teachings.

What he just said about wealth and generational wealth is something I never really heard framed this way. So I want to share this video with you. I'm also sharing some notes—like my own personal notes. Notes from the video, notes from my own mind, my own heart about this.

Before we get to generational wealth, he talks about generational worship. I like the way he defines worship.

RICK PIÑA • INTRO RECORDING

He talks about generational wisdom, and the wisdom is really coming from the Word of God. So we want to teach our children to worship—to yield our life to God's purpose for our lives—to seek the wisdom of the Lord. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of all wisdom. Then he talks about generational work. Because if you don't work, you're not going to eat, the Bible says. So we need to teach our children the disciplines around a work ethic that is godly, holy, and very disciplined. And then lastly, he talks about generational wealth and how a good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children.

The way he framed this all from the Bible, very practical, is something I just want to share with you. I'm giving you his video, notes from it, and my thoughts. I'm going to put this all together for you. I pray that this be a blessing to you. I believe it's going to be a blessing. So let's discuss it in the comments.

FROM RICK

Here is what this hit for me. Most wealth talk starts with money and hustle. Myron starts with worship. That order matters.

God is Source. Strategy is stewardship. I refuse to teach wealth tactics without teaching yield.

In our house, in ministry, and in business, I want the next generation to receive a clean baton, not a loud starting line with no foundation. Worship first. Wisdom from the Word. Work with a holy work ethic. Then wealth that can be left to your children's children.

RICK PIÑA

Four biblical steps, one baton

True generational wealth is not merely accumulating money for yourself. It is building, protecting, and passing on a package that lasts: a heart posture toward God, applied truth, a family enterprise, and an inheritance so future descendants never have to start from scratch.

Order matters. Wealth handed down without worship is eventually lost, or it becomes empty money without meaning.

Worship
Keeps the wealth. Yield across generations.

Wisdom
Builds the wealth. Apply truth, not only collect it.

03
Work
Builds the business. Family enterprise the next gen can enter.

04
Wealth
No descendant starts from scratch. Inheritance with righteousness.

Framed as a relay race: pass the full baton (all four), not only the easy pieces. Money alone is the lightest piece to toss and the easiest piece to lose. Worship, wisdom, and work are heavier, but they keep the money from becoming a curse.

Generational Worship

YIELDED POSITION, NOT SUNDAY PERFORMANCE

Myron's definition + distinctions

Worship is not “praise with hands raised.” Praise is an upward expression. Worship is a downward position: yielding to God's purpose for your life, recognizing God's sovereignty.

Key principle: anytime generational wealth was handed down without generational worship, the wealth was lost, because everything already belongs to God.

Money vs. wealth: people can leave millions without loving God. That is money, not wealth, and often without meaning. Heaven gives earth meaning. Earth gives heaven expression. Getting orders from God fills life even before the money arrives.

BIBLICAL ANCHORS (AS TAUGHT)

Exodus 3:6 (God of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob). Genesis 17:7 (everlasting covenant with seed). Genesis 13:2; 24:1-2, 34-36 (Abraham's richness tied to blessing). Judges 2:10-15 (generation that knew not the Lord loses protection/provision/land).

Practical application

- Daily yielded leadership at home, not Sunday performance while rebelling Mon-Sat
- Teach children who God is and what He has done (break the Judges pattern)
- Frame business success as stewardship of what is already God's
- Ask “Is God king of me?” before “How do I get richer?”

Praise goes up as expression. Worship bows down as position, yielding to God's purpose.

MYRON GOLDEN (PARAPHRASED)

Generational Wisdom

APPLY TRUTH. DO NOT STOP AT INFORMATION.

Myron's definition + distinctions

Wisdom is applying God's truth to life experience. Skillful application of truth, not mere information. You can know how without knowing why. Wisdom does the Word.

1 Ignorance

2 Knowledge

3 Understanding

4 Wisdom

! Foolishness = abandon truth

Ignorance = absence of truth. Knowledge = accumulation. Understanding = assimilation. Wisdom = application.

Foolishness = abandoning truth after having it.

BIBLICAL ANCHORS (AS TAUGHT)

Proverbs 10:1; 15:20; 29:3; 17:25 (wise son vs. foolish son). Esau / birthright themes (short-term appetite vs. long-term inheritance). Ecclesiastes 2:18-19 (labor left to an unknown heir; Solomon caution after prosperity).

Practical application

- Disciple kids through the full pipeline: knowledge to understanding to doing
- Measure wisdom by applied obedience, not IQ or Bible trivia
- Protect against "foolish son" outcomes that turn inheritance into grief
- After success, stay yielded. Do not credit self and lose the kingdom

When you get orders from headquarters and do what you were made for, life feels full, even before the money.

Generational Work

FAMILY ENTERPRISE, NOT ONLY “GET A JOB”

Myron’s definition + distinctions

Generational work is a family business: an enterprise the next generation can enter, learn in, and inherit, not merely “get a job.” The kingdom operates like a household you are born into and inherit, not only a corporation you get hired into.

Jesus at 12: “about my Father’s business” (Luke 2:49). The Father works / the Son works; the Son does what He sees the Father do (John 5:17, 5:19). Kingdom parables often use business imagery.

Desire vs. want: desire framed as of/from the Father. Wealth as ability to turn what you have into what you desire from the Father. The path often requires releasing what you have.

BIBLICAL / KINGDOM PATTERN (AS TAUGHT)

Luke 2:49; John 5:17, 5:19; household inheritance pattern; business imagery in kingdom parables. Model: pay family/team well and on time; let kids learn how money is made inside the enterprise.

Practical application

- Build or join a family enterprise with clear SOPs, roles, and fair pay
- Bring kids into real work early; teach ownership, not entitlement
- Use business as discipleship: character, skill, customer value, stewardship
- Worked-out family business so Step 4 (wealth transfer) has a vehicle
- Cultural shield: kids see real work/wealth at home, not only street counterfeits

Generational Wealth

NO DESCENDANT STARTS FROM SCRATCH

Myron's definition + distinctions

Intentional building of assets and inheritance so none of your future descendants ever have to start from scratch. House and riches as inheritance pattern. Ambition without avarice, because you are building for others.

Not lifestyle flex that consumes the inheritance. Multi-generational transfer: assets, business equity, housing, education capital, plus the faith package that keeps assets from becoming empty money.

BIBLICAL ANCHORS (AS TAUGHT)

Give the next generation a head start you wish you had. Inheritance to children's children. House and riches of fathers. Wealth of the sinner laid up for the just. 1 Timothy 5:8 (provide for one's own). Psalm 112:1-3 (riches + righteousness in the same house). Deuteronomy 8:18 (power to get wealth to establish covenant).

Practical application

- Plan multi-gen transfer: assets, equity, housing, education capital
- Reject "spending my children's inheritance"
- Holy ambition without the Lamborghini as the goal
- Tie wealth-building back to Steps 1-3 (Deut 8:18 why)
- Pass worship + wisdom + work + wealth as one package
